Registration and Fees

Third Age's Membership Year runs from 1st October to 30th September in the following year.

Annual membership is £5 and class fees are shown below.

Term dates are as follows:

Autumn: Monday 6th October 2025 to Friday 12th December 2025
(10 weeks - **£20 per term**)

Winter: Monday 5th January 2026 to Friday 13th March 2026
(10 weeks - **£20 per term**)

The fees are different for the following activities:

Book Club: annual membership fee plus **£8** for the year.

Reading Great Literature Together: membership fee plus **£10** per 10 week term.

Some classes also arrange to meet during the Summer and fees will be charged based on the length of the term.
